

Application Requirements and Submissions for International Students

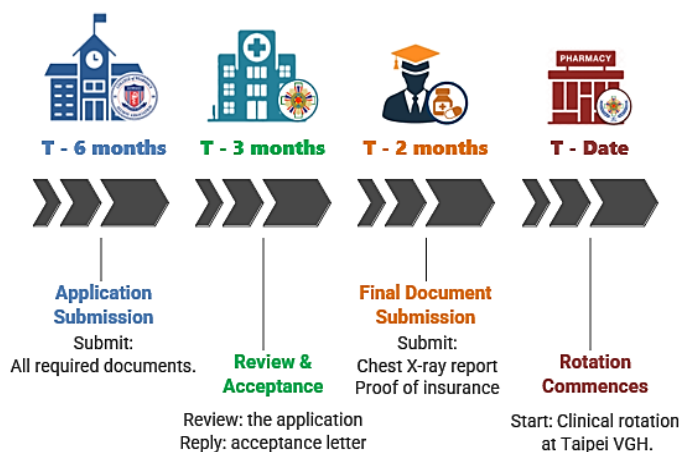
General requirements:

- Applicants must be healthy and keep good performance records at their own school.
- Fluency in Mandarin or Taiwanese, especially speaking and comprehension, is preferred, although not essential.

Required Materials (English edition is required if the originals are in other forms of language)

1. Digital passport-size photo.
2. Copy of your passport.
3. Copy of your student ID (both sides, with valid dates) or enrollment certificate from your medical school showing dates and official stamps. Applicants must be enrolled in a medical school and be in clinical years.
4. Letter of recommendation from the Dean or a faculty member proving that you are in the final two years of the medical program (clinical years)..
5. Curriculum vitae.
6. Official academic transcript(s).
7. Proof of personal travel and health insurance with coverage approximately NT\$1,000,000 that will cover the dates of your travel and study in Taiwan. (You could submit it **AFTER** your application has been approved).
8. Normal chest X-ray report signed or stamped by a physician, conducted within 90 days prior to the start or reporting date of your elective, demonstrating no suspicion of tuberculosis (TB). (You could submit it **AFTER** your application has been approved);
9. COVID-19 Vaccination Records with one to three doses of inoculation (if you have it).

Please be reminded that all applications must be submitted to and received by the Department of Medical Education, Taipei VGH, at least **3 months** prior to the expected start date of clinical study.
